The Lusitano Collection was presented at Interagro's farm in Brazil for its first three years. With the advent of the Lusitano Collection in the United States, buyers in America can purchase a horse that has not only passed rigorous veterinary scrutiny, but has completed the time-consuming and costly process of importation.
